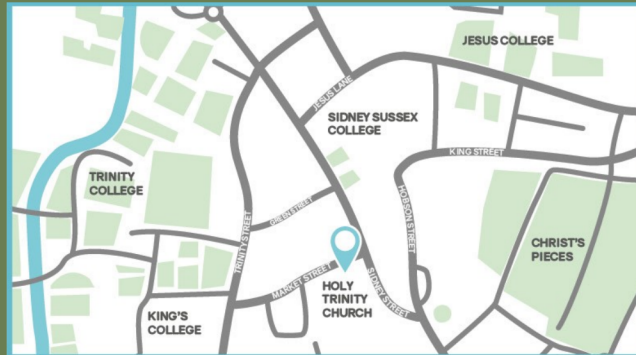


Ros Couchman

# New Creations

New Creations is for parents and carers of children from newborn to the end of primary school. We meet on Wednesdays at Holy Trinity Church and the group is run by church members. Each week begins at 10AM with coffee and cake.
